Teamwork, fitness, health, and a strong sense of belonging are all traits Omega aspires to, all things which sport teaches us in abundance.

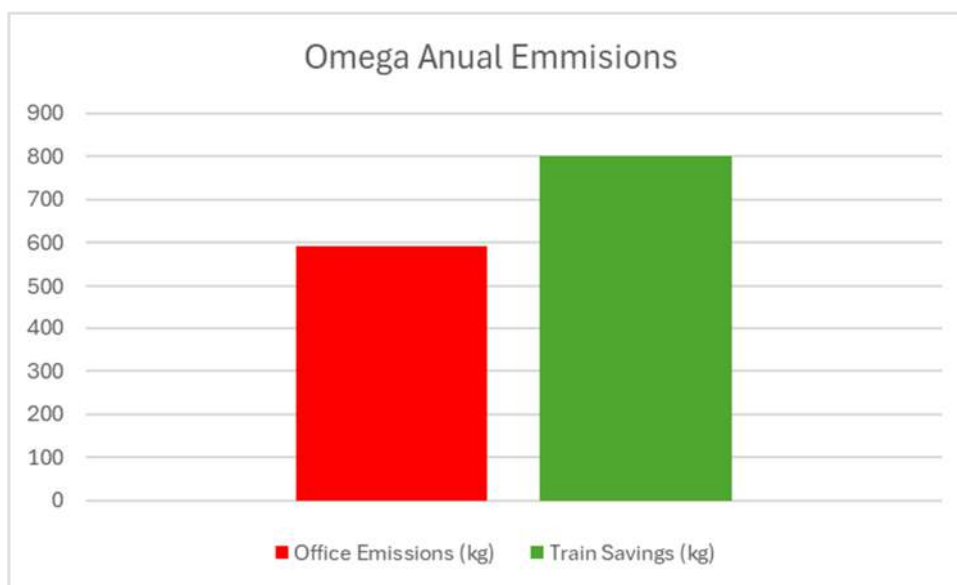

# Energy and Emissions

## Energy

At Omega our small office is the extent of our emissions through energy usage. With an average of 50Kg of Co2 a month our office annually releases 600Kg of Co2. This value seems high but when factoring in emissions saved from train journeys that could have been driven (80% less emissions) we can offset our office energy usage.



## Emissions

Our primary output of Co2 is due to car emissions, this year we drove almost 45,000 miles to visit various sites up and down the country. This resulted in almost a tonne of Co2 being released into the atmosphere. While our business is focused on helping retailers reduce emissions, we would like to offset our own emissions. Make It Wild is a company that for a fee will plant trees to offset carbon emissions, this costs just £140 for 10 tonnes of carbon offsets. These trees will be used to preserve nature reserves in the UK and once planted we will be given the location and will be able to visit our own trees.

## Future

As we move into the new year Omega Solutions will continue to provide consultation to a variety of retailers across the country and will begin working with new clients. We are also looking forward to the rollout of NowData and Micro Pipe, expanding the business beyond consultation.
